Range Rules and Safety Procedures are paramount at Newberry Pistol Club. Please review these rules all shooters must follow on the club ranges. Any shooter posing a danger to others will be subject to removal from the club grounds & membership can be revoked if a shooter continues to show poor safety procedures. Any new shooter may ask for an introduction to gun handling procedures. Please let any member know you are a new shooter and would like an introduction. Range Rules:

- Always follow the NRA safety rules: Treat every gun as if it is loaded. Keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction, keep your finger off the trigger until ready to fire, know what's in front of and beyond the target.
- No handling or uncasing of firearms when people are down range.
- Do not approach the firing line until called by the RSO.
- An uncased gun must be in use on the firing line holstered or on the bench, unloaded with the action open and ECI inserted.
- When moving with a firearm, have the action open and the muzzle pointed down range.
- No moving when the firearm is loaded, or the action closed.
- Actions may be closed only when told to by the RSO or instructor.
- Be sure the range is clear before shooting.
- Bottle neck ammo is NOT allowed on indoor ranges.
- Only pistols, pistol carbine or .22 LR caliber rifles can be used on indoor range.
- Steel target shooting shall NOT be conducted within 10 yards.
- Pick up your shell cases when the range is verified safe by the RSO.
- Help the range officer keep the area clean. Police your brass.
- All duds and misfires must be removed from club grounds by the owner. Do not leave them on the ground or put them in the trash.
- Always have an RSO check the barrel with a ramrod after any abnormal discharge.
- Eye and ear protection must be worn by all shooters and guests during all live fire events.
- You are not allowed to pass a gun to another person while on the firing line. If you are sharing a gun, then each shooter must shoot his complete round and then pass the unloaded gun to the next person.
- Follow all instructions of the Range Master, and Club Management. Range officers are authorized to remove any shooter whose behavior is detrimental to the safe operations of any of the ranges.
- Follow the Range Officer's directions immediately. Arguing or unsportsmanlike behavior will cause you to be removed from the firing line, and possibly be trespassed from club property.
- If an emergency cease fire is called, all firearms must be immediately unloaded and stowed. Do not handle firearms during an emergency cease fire.
- Only individuals that are shooting are permitted on the firing line unless they have the permission of the range officer before the round begins.
- Only authorized personnel are permitted forward of the firing line.
- Individuals that have never shot a match before will be required to shoot 3 competitions under the supervision of an experienced individual authorized by a range officer.
- All shooters are subject to a safety check at any time.
- All shooters must be legally able to own and operate a firearm and not a "Prohibited Person" as defined by the federal and state laws.
- Your club member host is responsible for the compliance of additional range specific rules in the SOP.
